In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that requisition letters must be submitted by your Examination Centre/EMH with the District Collector & Magistrate and Superintendent of Police of your district with copy to the IIC of the local police station for deputation of representatives of the district administration and police personnel to your Examination Centres, and deployment of armed police personnel for round the clock security of the EMHs and escorting the transportation vehicle for dispatch of questions from the EMH to Examination Centres and bringing back the answer scripts from Examination Centres to EMH. A copy of the examination schedule of your Examination Centre/EMH must be enclosed with the requisition.

Reporting and presence of representatives of district administration and police personnel must be ensured and necessary follow-up action be taken. In case of non-compliance, the same must be intimated to the Controller of Examinations by SMS/Whatsapp message (Mob: -9437144124) followed by formal mail to the Controller of Examinations (e-mail id : coechseodisha@gmail.com) on the same date.

Non-submission of requisition letter and not intimating the absence of representatives of district administration and police personnel will be viewed seriously.
